Our topic this half term is...

'At the Zoo'

I will be learning...

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE AND LITERACY

We will be developing writing opportunities for children in preparation for Year 1. Please get your child to practise their High Frequency Words daily and applying them in a meaningful context, for example writing sentences and stories.

MATHEMATICS

We will be developing our knowledge and understanding of numbers with a focus on addition, subtraction and doubling and halving. We encourage you to talk to your child about adding two amounts together to find the total. Practise number bonds 10.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

Our topic this half term is 'At the Zoo', so we shall be using our imagination to role play lots of different stories. We will be creating masks focusing on a range of tools and techniques to use as props during our performances. We will continue to explore musical instruments and dance within our play. You can listen to music at home with your child to enable them to build up a repertoire of songs.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMO-TIONAL DEVELOPMENT

We will be learning how to manage and express our feelings and behaviour through different texts and activities.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

We will be focusing on developing children's fundamental movement skills. Children will develop skills of balancing, running, hopping, jumping, travelling and changing direction. They will develop fine and gross motor skills, through handling equipment, learn how to stay safe using space, work independently and with a partner to complete tasks. Please ensure your child has a full P.E kit. Please talk to your child at home about the importance of sleep, healthy eating and hygiene.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

We will be learning about different zoo animals. We hope to visit London Zoo!

We will be learning the life cycle of ladybirds and we're very excited for the arrival of our own eggs. We will be talking lots about what makes us special and what we enjoy doing with our family.

HOMEWORK

Please read with your child every day. Levelled books are changed everyday when a comment has been written in your child's reading record.

Please ensure your child completes a Maths activity (from the Summer term Maths homework booklet). This can be recorded on the booklet or on Tapestry.

Ensure you child is practising reading and writing.

Dear Parents & Carers...

We work in partnership with you to make your child's experience in Reception a happy one. We encourage our parents/carers to:

- Develop a good routine to ensure your child arrives to school on time.
 - Encourage your child to be more independent. Let them sort out their own items for school, such as lunchboxes, coats and shoes etc.
 - Listen to them read or asking them about the books they are reading and encouraging them to read every day.
 - Practise numeracy skills in a friendly and informal way – number games.
 - Show an interest in your child's day and talk about what they have been learning.
 - Encourage and support them to do their homework by themselves. Remember - it is their homework, not yours.
