I will be learning...

ENGLISH



We will be looking at a Shakespearean text and focusing on writing a descriptive scene and a diary entry. In Autumn 2, we will be completing a letter based upon a story set in World War II.

MATHS

Children will continue to work on place value and the four operations as well as carrying out some exciting investigations. Remember: keep practicing your times tables at home!

HUMANITIES

Our History unit this term is World War II. We will be investigating the causes of the War and what life was like during this period.

SCIENCE

Our first topic this term is Space. We will be focusing on investigative skills and developing our enquiring minds! In Autumn 2, we will be learning about the lifecycles of different living things, such as birds, butterflies and plants.

ART & D.T. In Autumn 1, during their art unit, children will be completing a piece of work inspired by the artist Ibrahim El-Salahi.

In Autumn 2's DT topic, children will be inspired by some wartime recipes and learn how to make dumplings.

R.E. Children will be investigating what people believe about God through the lenses of psychology and theology.
