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SPORTS PREMIUM FUNDING

At Cyril Jackson Primary School, we believe that sports and extra-curricular clubs play an important role in promoting social inclusion, healthy lifestyle and self-confidence.

What is the Sports Premium?

From September 2014, the government is providing additional funding of £150 million per annum to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This means we will receive £9,775 per for the academic year 2017 - 2018. This funding - provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and sport - will be allocated to primary school Headteachers and is ring-fenced and therefore can only be spent on provision of PE and sport in schools.

Purpose of the funding

All schools have to spend the sport funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but there is freedom to choose how we do it. Our aim is to maintain the quality and quantity of sports and after-school clubs, inter and intra school competitions, as well as to raise opportunities for pupils to try different activities whilst raising participation numbers.

At Cyril Jackson Primary School we recognise the contribution of PE to the health and well-being of the children. We believe that an innovative and varied PE curriculum and extra-curricular opportunities have a positive influence on the concentration, attitude and academic achievement of all children. Furthermore through sports and physical activity we aim to develop a greater awareness about dangers such as obesity, smoking and other such activities that can have a detrimental impact upon pupil health and well-being.

Use of the funding at Cyril Jackson Primary School

The money will be used so that all children benefit regardless of their sporting ability. We will continue to place a high priority on our PE provision and, as such, have invested in additional staffing and resources to further enhance the PE curriculum as well as extra-curricular sports during lunchtime and after schools clubs.



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Other uses of the funding:

- To pay for cover staff to undertake professional development opportunities.
- To pay for a sports coach during lunchtimes
- To fund a sports coach to run after school, intra - school, sports competitions.
- Continuing Professional Development (CPD) and network meetings for PE subject leaders.
- To pay for resources to be replenished and kept up to date.
- To help fund *Healthy Schools Week* within school.

Sustainability

In order to sustain and widen the sporting opportunities for our children we provide a sports coach at lunchtimes. In addition to this we offer paid after-school clubs and we benefit from the Tower Hamlets Healthy Lives team offering an after-school fitness clubs for identified pupils who are deemed to be over-weight.

In addition to the clubs, Sports' Leaders training has been provided to our older children so they can facilitate sports games and activities during lunchtime.

A 'Smooga' board (creates a cordoned off section) which has been introduced to the south building playground allowing identified games to be played which have their own designated space as well as other smaller games too.



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Impact of funding

We offer a greater range of competitive sports as well as the opportunity to experience sporting activities which our pupils would not otherwise be able to access (see below our coach registers and lists of competitions entered for 2015-16 and 2016-17).
