English




Children will be reading and writing stories with a familiar setting! They will have the opportunity to write their own versions with new settings, characters and details. They will also, as part of Black History Month, be writing diaries

MATHEMATICS

During our Maths lessons, we will be focusing on place value and ordering numbers correctly. We will be recapping the number bonds to 10



HISTORY

Our History focus in Autumn will be the Victorians. The children will be learning about daily life and significant people. During Black History Month, they will learn about the life of Mary Seacole.

SCIENCE

Our Science focus will be on Animals, including Humans and Materials. We will be investigating what basic needs are, how we change as we grow and the properties of different materials.



MUSIC Children will be learning about different percussion instruments and how to perform using them.
