



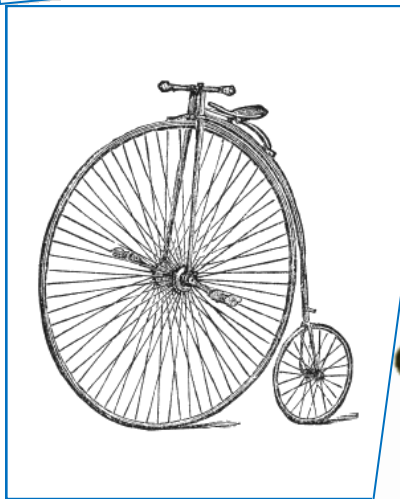
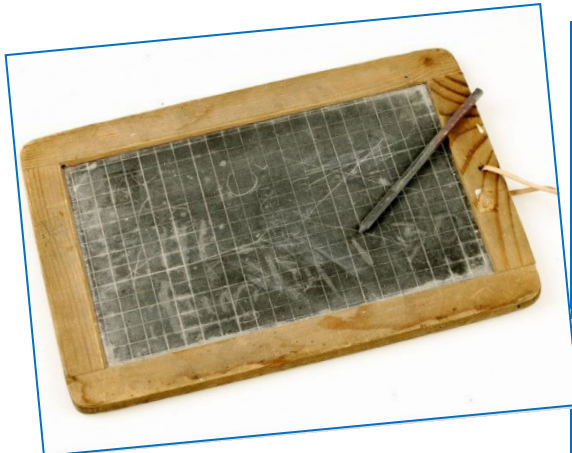

Learn a Victorian game. Can you write a set of instructions on how to play it to teach the class?

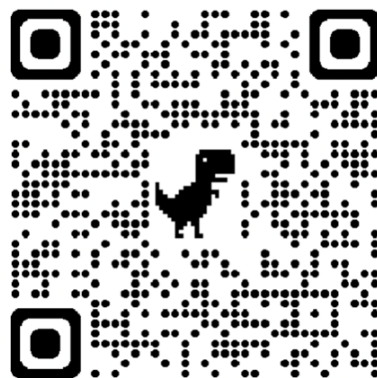


## Queen Victoria

If you are on a smartphone or tablet:

1. Download the **Duolingo** app and open it up.
2. Press **Get Started**. Then select **Spanish**.
3. Set your Daily Goal and continue (you can change this later).
4. Create a Profile:
  - On Android, press the menu icon at the top right corner and press **Create a Profile**.
  - On iOS, press **Profile** in the top left corner and press **Create a Profile**.
5. Type in your **Name**, **Email** and **Password**, then press **Create**.
6. Go to your **Profile** and press **Progress Sharing**.
7. Type in your Classroom Code: **DXAHQJ**
8. Press **Join Class**.
