Seeking ideas to shape the future of St Anne's Church

Dear Neighbour,

St Anne's is the parish church of Limehouse, a special building and a significant landmark. Internationally famous, **it was designed by Nicholas Hawksmoor almost 300 years ago.** It is a vitally important anchor in Limehouse's history, religious life, and community.

This Grade 1 listed building is now in urgent need of major and extensive restoration (currently on Historic England's "Buildings at Risk" Register). The costs of the required works are far beyond the capacity of the congregation. Starter funding has been awarded by the National Lottery Heritage Fund (NLHF) to enable us to explore and develop a full forward plan.

How can St Anne's church be reshaped to better benefit the wider Limehouse community?
