I will be learning...

Communication and Language:

We will be learning to listen and engage with stories, songs and rhymes.

Literacy: We will be beginning to write our names and listening to stories in small groups. We will be focusing on nursery rhymes.

Numeracy:

We will be learning to sing number songs, count and recognise numbers. Recognising shapes and talking about size.



Understanding the World:

We will be exploring our local environment on trips to the park and talking about our families and homes. We will also be learning about the different festivals that are taking place.



Expressive Arts and Design:

We will be learning new songs and rhymes and exploring different materials and media. We will also have a chance to engage in imaginative role-play.

Computing

We will be learning to use the mouse and use simple programmes. We will also be using ICT equipment within our day and exploring interactive games.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be learning how to interact with our peers and how to share our toys. We will also be developing our understanding of rules.

Physical Development

We will be learning how to use the outdoor equipment safely including the local park equipment. We will also be learning how to stay clean and healthy and how to become independent.



Our Topic

Our topic this half term is Ourselves. We will be talking about where people live, what we look like and the different parts of our body, feelings and how we have grown.

- ◆ Ensure your child has plenty of sleep (12 hours)

- ◆ Make sure your child eats breakfast before Nursery.

- ◆ Support your child to become independent by helping them practice putting on their coat and shoes.

- ◆ Show an interest in your child's day and talk about what they have done.

- ◆ Share books with your child every day, talk about the pictures and points of interest.

- ◆ Practice numeracy skills in a friendly and informal way e.g. counting stairs, buses etc.

- ◆ If you or your child have any questions or worries please just come and let us know - No matter how small.

Things you will need in Nursery...

SCHOOL SHOES
