I will be learning...

Communication and Language:

We will be thinking about alliteration and describing. We will also be talking about our own experiences.

Literacy:

This term we will be learning the following stories: Naughty Bus, The Train Ride and The Three Billy Goats Gruff.

Numeracy:

This term we will be learning about 2D shapes, counting, representing number in different ways and making arrangements with shapes.



Understanding the World:

We will be exploring our local environment on trips to the park, and Shadwell. We will be learning about different modes of transport as well as the natural environment.



Expressive Arts and Design:

We will be exploring salt dough, oil pastels, water colours, patterns in pictures, collage and 3D sculptures!

Computing

We will be learning how to follow instructions and record on different devices such as the iPod, recordable whiteboards and flipcams. We will also be developing our mouse control and using Beebots.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be learning how to talk about our feelings, and how to behave in a safe and sensible way outside the Nursery setting. We will also be developing our independence in looking after ourselves.

Physical Development

We will be learning how to move rhythmically to music, throwing and kicking skills, catching and controlling the ball and moving in different directions.



Our Topic Our topic for Spring 1 is Transport, Buildings and Structures and our topic for Spring 2 is Under the Sea. We will also be celebrating Book Week and Science Week.

SCHOOL SHOES

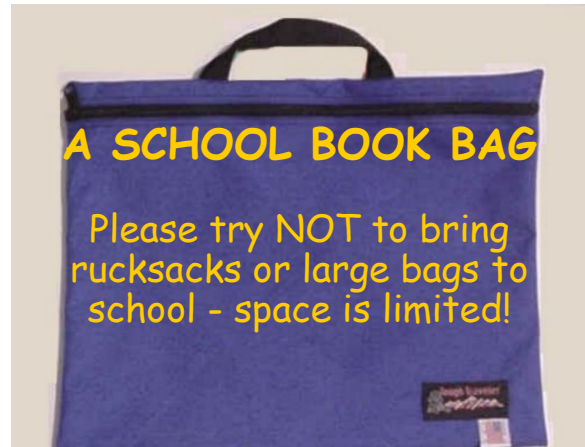
Plimsolls or lace-ups. Trainers can be worn, as long as they are completely black.
