I will be learning...

LITERACY

We will be focussing on writing adventure stories and will be studying the work of children's author, Roald Dahl. We will also be writing an information leaflet on the health of our teeth, which will link to our Science.



NUMERACY

During our maths lessons, we will be focusing on learning number facts and practising methods for calculation and problem solving.

It is vital that children continue to practise and learn their times tables at home.



HUMANITIES

Our topic for this term is linked to Geography. We will be studying our local area which we will compare with a rural English village in the summer term.

SCIENCE

Our topics this term will be *Teeth & Eating* and *Rocks & Soils*. We will be looking at our diets and learning about the importance of different foods.

Different foods are important in different ways.



I.C.T.

During ICT will be learning to create surveys and opinion polls. We will also be designing comics that encourage children to look after their teeth.

Music

Children will continue to learn to play the guitar.

R.E.

Children will be learning about Jesus and why the bible is important to Christians.

PSHE

This term children will be exploring the themes around families, friends and relationships.

We will be designing and taste testing sandwiches with different breads and fillings. We will be portraying relationships in art.

Children will be given weekly homework tasks to complete linked to Literacy and Numeracy. Homework books are due each **TUESDAY** when it will be marked.
