- ◆ Bring your PE Kit in on PE days: this must be a t-shirt, shorts/jogging bottoms and trainers.

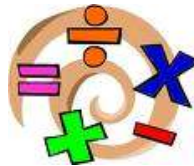
LITERACY

We will be focussing on writing adventure stories and will be studying the work of William Shakespeare. We will also be writing an information leaflet on the health of our teeth, which will link to our Science.



NUMERACY

During our maths lessons, we will be focusing on learning number facts and practising methods for calculation and problem solving. It is vital that children continue to practise and learn their times tables at home.



SCIENCE

Our topics this term will be *Teeth & Eating* and *Rocks & Soils*. We will be looking at different food groups and learning about the importance of a varied diet.



I.C.T.

During ICT will be learning to create surveys and opinion polls. We will also be designing comics that encourage children to look after their teeth.
